Delivered by a representative from one of the ATIEL (Technical Association of the European Lubricants Industry) technical committees, this half-day session will guide you through the often complex issues around the formulation, blending and marketing of engine lubricants that claim to meet European OEM (ACEA) performance specifications.

- The structure of the European Engine Lubricants Quality Management System (EELQMS) and its value in maintaining quality across the UK automotive lubricants market
- The role of the ATIEL Code of Practice within EELQMS and the overall engine lubricant development process
- When and how to apply Code of Practice interchange guidelines for base oils, viscosity grade read-across and viscosity modification
- What you need to do to demonstrate compliance with the EELQMS in order to make ACEA performance claims

To test your undestanding we'll also work through a few simple exercises. By the end of the course you should know - whether you are a formulator, marketer, blender or rebrander - how to make valid and compliant performance claims for your products.

The course will end with an open question and answer session where you'll have the chance to raise any outstanding issues or queries.
