

Set up in 2008 in memory of her son Oliver, who died from leukaemia aged nine. Avril Mills BEM helped to grant a dream for a little boy who wanted to visit a football club. That day, Oliver said, "Mum, when I grow up I want to grant dreams just like you". Sadly, Oliver never got that chance, but the premise for The Dream Factory was founded.

We aim to do everything possible to grant a child's dream, which could be to meet their favourite celebrity, their favourite sporting hero, visit Disneyland for the day, or own a laptop. No dream is too small. All our dreams are made possible with the invaluable help of our fabulous Dream Makers who are all volunteers.
